Hello Nottinghill Families!










# MOVIE NIGHT

#### **Drinking Water at Nottinghill Cooperative Preschool**

If you were watching Global News last month and saw the story on water testing in the schools you might have noticed that Halton was the focus for water testing concerns. Some people have asked the Board about the water at Nottinghill and we are happy to boast that the standards at Nottinghill are very high and we consistently exceed ministry expectations.




The results of our latest water testing (a test that is conducted at the beginning of each school year) are posted on the boards across from the cubbies for your information and reference. As you will see, the results clearly state that traces of lead are undetectable.

It's also important to note that the teachers take great care to run the taps each day as part of their daily routine to ensure any "sitting water" is flushed. Lastly, the average volume of cold water consumed at school by any child about 1/4 cup of water per school day.
