## 2019-2020 Registration

One final reminder that registration for the 2019-2020 school year opens to the public this Saturday, February 2 at our Open House. Some of our classes are quickly filling up, so if you are planning to enroll your child for September, please take advantage of this early opportunity to secure your spot before the weekend!

To register, all you need to do is drop off the non-refundable registration fee of \$75 in the Registrar's box at the school, along with the completed registration forms (printed copies available in white envelopes at the school) or a note with your child's name and class selection for next year with the completed forms to follow at your earliest convenience. For JK/SK registrations only, we also require a non-refundable payment of the first month's fees of \$360 to secure your spot. Please be sure that all cheques are payable to Nottinghill Cooperative Preschool. To ensure you reserve your spot, **please register by Friday, February 1.**
