

Just a reminder that we will be taking the children outdoors whenever possible. So good for them (and us!) to get a bit of that crisp cold air! The Ministry regulations say we cannot take the younger children (2am, 3am and 3pm) outdoors if the temperatures are -10 degrees or colder, including the wind chill. For the JK/SK class the regulations are -12 degrees or colder, including the wind chill. If you are unsure, we ask that you bring all their gear along. Please label all of their belongings so they can be returned to the proper home.

As you were made aware last week the Ministry has provided child care centres with rapids tests. We are waiting for more to arrive so we can provide each family with 2 tests to be kept at home

should their child develop symptoms. In the meantime, please reach out to your child's teacher or Miss Kim if you need one as we have a small supply on hand. If your child or anyone in your household had any symptoms listed on the screening form, we ask that you follow the proper Covid-19 protocol and isolate for 5/10 days. We want to keep everyone safe and healthy. Should you have any questions about any of the testing requirements or screening protocols, please do not hesitate to reach out.

A friendly reminder that we cannot have families stay after class to play on the church property. As tempting as the big snow banks are we are being reminded from the church staff it is not permitted. We have noticed some families taking advantage of the park across the road, looks like lots of fun!! Please do not hesitate to reach out to your child's teacher if you have any questions, comments or concerns. Our door is always open!!!




### **COVID-19 Prescreening Tool**

As a reminder, please complete our online prescreen every day before dropping off your child.

If your family is travelling internationally, we want to remind you of the federal directives for international travel. While unvaccinated children under the age of 12 who travelled internationally with a fully vaccinated companion are exempt from federal quarantine, they are not permitted to attend child care programs for 14 days following their return.
