January is an important month for Nottinghill, we have our Annual General Meeting (AGM). The AGM is on Wednesday, January 17, 2018 at 7:30pm in the Narthex. The Board of Directors has reviewed Nottinghill's programs and is working to address the issue of lower enrolment at Nottinghill. At the AGM the Board of Directors will provide an update on our activities as well as provide you a summary of the annual survey responses.
