Message from the Teachers

Hello, and Happy November!

It's hard to believe we have already completed the first 2 months of school! We are so impressed with how well everyone has settled, and the improvement in everyone's self-help skills already! The children continue to work on their independence with toileting (undies and pants on and off on their own!), changing their shoes, and we are learning the 1 -2 – Fliparoo to get our coats on! Practicing these skills at home before snow – suit season is always a great idea, and will help when getting ready for school as well!

October was a great month of celebrations, with Thanksgiving and Halloween crafts decorating our schools and probably your homes! All of our favourite little monsters had a great time at the Halloween parties, with a costume parade, a special treat, lots of games, and of course the Monster Freeze Dance! Thank you to our In – Class party committee for the wonderful take home treat! We also had a lot of fun during circles exploring our class pumpkins, making guesses on what might be inside of them, as well as voting and

graphing on what kind of Pumpkin Face we would carve in our Jack – O – Lanterns!

In November we will be starting our Under the Sea, and Healthy Me themes, finishing with Shapes! Our Under the Sea theme is always covered in glitter, so the teachers apologize in advance! We will also learn some fun facts about the most exciting sea creatures, from the strangest fish to everyone's favourite, the shark!

Healthy Me will start with our Glitter Germ experiment, where we will show the children how our germs can spread to toys, and friends, and how to properly wash our hands to send those germs down the drain instead! We will also discuss rainbow foods that keep our bodies strong, and how to make sure our teeth stay healthy!

November also marks the start of our Jolly Phonics! We will discuss a letter each week (A-Z), starting with our Letter Bag (items that start with that sound), our Jolly Phonics tracing sheet each week, and our Storybots Letter Song on Friday!




Mabel's Labels

Did you know Nottinghill offers a top rated JK/SK class?

Our program runs 5 afternoons and is a wonderful alternative to full day kindergarten. We offer the following areas of focused learning:

Literacy:

• Explode the Code

A series of literacy workbooks that teaches letters and their sounds as well as letter formation through visual, auditory, and kinesthetic activities.

Reading Program

Readers (books) are practiced at school and sent home every week for further practice. Each week students receive a new one to learn and master.

• Weekly Journaling

Weekly journaling allows children to express themselves through drawing pictures and simple writing.



Math and Science:

Nottinghill students are regularly exposed to math and science concepts.

Math concepts include: Measurement, time, classification, patterning and shapes in two dimensions.

Nottinghill's science units allow students to explore problems, estimations, and science experiments and activities.





Introduction to French

Children are exposed to basic French concepts such as colours, numbers and days of the week.

Music and Art

A variety of art and music activities are incorporated into day-to-day learning.
